## INDEPENDENCE DAY & SRI AUROBINDO JAYANTHI

August 15<sup>th</sup> –A day of dual celebration for all of us. It marks the end of the British rule .On the same day in the year 1872 a great freedom fighter and a spiritual leader was born who played a great role in the freedom struggle.

The first part of Sri Aurobindo's message to the new nation, broadcast on All -India Radio 60 years ago: “August 15th 1947 is the birthday of free India. It marks for her the end of an

old era, the beginning of a new age. But we can also make it by our life and acts as a free nation an important date in a new age opening for the whole world, for the political, social, cultural and spiritual future of humanity..... August 15th is my own birthday and it is naturally gratifying to me that it should have assumed this vast significance.”

The achievement of Independence was only a prel-

ude to India 's future role as a world power – an essential stage in order that the qualities of India 's soul might re-emerge from the sleep of ages and be given to the world.
